Ring 1 – classes commence at 9am and subsequent classes will follow

Class 1 – Working Pony/Cob TSR & Sunshine Tour Qualifier

Open to mares and geldings aged four or over. A course of rustic fences will be jumped. Once all competitors have jumped, you will then be called back into the ring for individual shows and conformation assessment.

Class 1a – Kindly sponsored by PONY Magazine

Ponies must be 4yrs or over and not exceed 143cm. Rider not to have attained their 16th birthday. Jumps will not exceed 60cm.

Class 1b – Ponies must be 4yrs over, exceeding 143cm but not exceeding 153cm. Riders any age permitted. Jumps will not exceed 75cm.

Class 2 – Working Hunter/Cob TSR & Sunshine Tour Qualifier

Kindly sponsored by Bridgefield Physiotherapy Ltd

Open to mares and geldings aged four or over. All horses to exceed 153cm. A course of rustic fences will be jumped first. Once all competitors have jumped, you will then be called back into the ring for individual shows and conformation assessment. The judge will ride. Class may be split into weight depending on entries. Jumps will not exceed 85cm.

Class 3 – Ridden Hunter TSR & Sunshine Tour Qualifier

Open to horses aged four or over. Class may be split by weight depending on entries. Judge will ride.

Working and Hunter Championship

Ring 1 – continued

Classes 4 & 5 not to start before 1pm

Class 4 - Riding Horse/Hack TSR & Sunshine Tour Qualifier

Open to mares and geldings aged four or over, exceeding 148cm. Class may be split if enough entries. Judge will ride.

Class 5 – Ridden cobs TSR & Sunshine Tour Qualifier

Open to horses aged four or over, exceeding 148cm. Class may be split by weight depending on entries. Judge will ride.

Ring 2 - classes commence at 9am and subsequent classes will follow

Class 6 - Ridden Mountain & Moorland TSR & Sunshine Tour Qualifier

Open to horses aged four or over, large and small breeds, pure or part bred.

Class 7 - Ridden Veterans TSR & Sunshine Tour Qualifier

Open to horses/ponies aged 15 and over.

Class 8 – Ridden Coloureds TSR & Sunshine Tour Qualifier

Open to horses aged four or over. Any type or breed to include roan, spotted and odd coloured.

Ring 2 – continued

Classes 9 and 10 - Not to start before 1pm

Class 9 – Novice ridden *TSR & Sunshine Tour Qualifier*

Open to horses aged four or over. Any type/breed. For anybody that would like to give showing a go or is just starting out. Judge will not ride.

Class 10 – Riding Club Horse/Pony *TSR & Sunshine Tour Qualifier*

Open to horses aged four or over. Class may be split by horse height if enough competitors. Competitors will be asked to perform a short individual show which will include a small jump. Competitors should also include a halt of 5 seconds in their individual show. Horses/ponies should wear a simple snaffle bridle.

Ridden Championship – not to start before 2pm

For horses/ponies placed 1st or 2nd in classes 4-10

Ring 3 – classes commence at 9am and subsequent classes will follow

Class 11 - In-hand youngstock *TSR Qualifier*

Not exceeding four years.

Class 12 - In-hand coloureds *TSR & Sunshine Tour Qualifier*

Class 13 - In-hand Mountain & Moorland *TSR & Sunshine Tour Qualifier*

Large and small breeds, pure or part bred.

Ring 3 – continued

Class 14 – In-hand Novice *TSR Qualifier*

Open to any type/breed. For anybody who would like to give showing a go or is just starting out.

Class 15 - In-hand veterans *TSR & Sunshine Tour Qualifier*

Open to horses/ponies aged 15 and over.

In-hand championship - *Kindly sponsored by Ellie Osborne Photography*

For horses/ponies placed 1st or 2nd in classes 10-15

The following classes will not start before 2pm

The following classes can either be ridden/in-hand/lead-rein unless specified.

Class 16 - Fancy dress

Class 17 - Junior handler (in-hand only) *Sunshine Tour Qualifier*

Handlers to be 16 years and under. May be split by age group depending on entries.

Class 18 - Best lead-rein pony (lead-rein only) *Sunshine Tour Qualifier*

Class 19 - Best first ridden (ridden only) *Sunshine Tour Qualifier*

Riders will be asked to trot a simple figure of eight

Class 20 - Prettiest mare *Sunshine Tour Qualifier*

Class 21 - Handsomest gelding *Sunshine Tour Qualifier*

Munstead showing show rules and regulations

Your class entry shall be construed as acceptance of these rules and regulations

1. Some classes maybe split or joined depending on numbers on the day.
2. Where applicable, classes will be run under the Rules of the relevant Societies/Championship Organisers.
3. ONLINE ENTRIES preferred. Telephone or email entries cannot be guaranteed until the class fee is received.
4. Entries will not be refunded except on production of a vet's certificate with a £2 deduction to cover administration costs.
5. Hard hats up to current standard must be worn when mounted.
6. Lungeing is permitted in the lorry parking area.
7. The organiser/judge's decision is final.
8. Any complaints must be handed in to the secretary, in writing and within 10 minutes of the class finishing, along with a fee of £10.
9. Correct dress must be worn i.e. hard hats, gloves, shirt etc.
10. Any dangerous animals may be asked to leave the show.
11. Stallions must be declared on the entry form and be handled appropriately to avoid any accidents. **STALLION DISCS MUST BE WORN.** No rider/handler under 15yrs may exhibit a stallion in any class.
12. All dogs must be kept on a short lead.
13. Children under the age of 16 years of age must be supervised at all times. Do not leave your horse/pony left tied up outside the lorry/trailer unsupervised.
14. Report any accidents or damage to the Secretary immediately.
15. MBS paramedics will be in attendance. First aid fee charged per rider.
16. Any horse or pony, which is considered by a Judge or the Organisers to be too small for the jockey, unsound, unfit or unhealthy, will be excluded from further competition without any refund of entry fee.
17. **Abandonment:** In the event of abandonment £5.00 will be retained from each entry.
18. To be run under Current Government Covid Guidelines.

This show is a qualifier for the TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You DO NOT have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

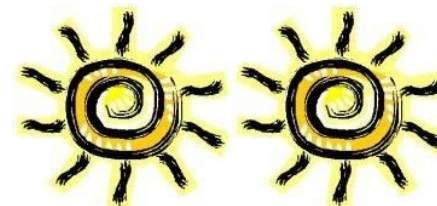
TSR Riders Finals – 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

Qualification: 1st – 6th place. Qualification does not pass down the line.
